

Crocus biflorus nubigena

Flowering Time	Spring
Distribution	W and SW Turkey; Aegean Islands
Native Climate	Mediterranean with montane influences
Wild Habitat	Open rocky places or thin scrub
Distinctive Features	White or lilac flowers. Blackish anthers. Minutely hairy style branches
Closest Relatives	Crocus biflorus creweji
Cultivation Requirements	Warm dry summer rest, winter protection advised
Availability	Occasionally in specialist seed lists
