

CROCUS BOULOSII

Flowering Time	Winter
Distribution	Libya
Native Climate	Cold wet winter, warm dry summer
Wild Habitat	Open stony places over limestone
Distinctive Features	White flowers with some dark markings at base of outerpetals. Membranous tunic ages to parallel fibres.
Closest Relatives	Crocus aleppicus; Crocus veneris
Cultivation	
Requirements	? Winter protection, warm dry summer rest
Availability	Not!

Not a very exciting species horticulturally. (But as its not available in commerce and barely in cultivation, this is unlikely to be an issue!) Smallish white flowers in midwinter and almost certain to need winter protection and a completely dry summer rest.
