

Crocus goulimyi leucanthus

Flowering Time	Autumn
Distribution	Greece (S E Peloponnese)
Native Climate	Mediterranean
Wild Habitat	Dry places over limestone. (Especially old/neglected olive and fig groves)
Distinctive Features	White or very pale lilac flowers. Coriaceous corm tunic
Closest Relatives	Crocus goulimyi goulimyi
Cultivation Requirements	Warm, well drained soil. Dry summer rest best. (This species is grown outside in some UK gardens but is more likely to thrive given some protection)
Availability	Available from some specialist bulb suppliers
