

Crocus antalyensis

Flowering Time	Spring
Distribution W	Turkey
Native Climate	Cold winter, dryish summer
Wild Habitat	Woodland clearings, scrub, open slopes
Distinctive Features	Flowers lilac or white, often with exterior markings. Corm tunic papery with long neck at apex
Closest Relatives	<u>Crocus flavus dissectus</u>
Cultivation Requirements	Well drained soil, plant deeply
Availability	Some specialist bulb nurseries and seed suppliers
