DICHOTOMOUS KEY OF IBERIAN WILD DAFFODIL SPECIES WITH STRICT AUTUMN FLOWERING

1. - Tepals yellow or green - 2
- Tepals whites - 3
2. - Tepals yellow. Very short perigonal tube, 1.5 to 4 mm long. Vestigial corona, barely visible, with six small entire or bilobed yellow scales. Much longer style than perigonal tube - ***N. cavanillesii*** Barra & G.Lopez

- Green tepals. Long perigonal tube, 14 to 20 mm long. Clearly visible corona, with six truncated, green scales. Style always shorter than perigonal tube - ***N. viridiflorus*** Schousb .
3. - No leaves during flowering . Always single flowered. Pedicels less than 20 mm long . Perigonal tube abruptly widened in its middle part . Yellow or greenish corona in the young flowers, never orange, with six deep segments - ***N. serotinus*** L.

- Without any, with one or with two leaves during flowering. Umbels with 2, multi or rarely single flowers. Pedicels between 10 and 65 mm length. Perigonal tube gradually widened. Orange or greenish corona, (sub)entire or with three scales - 4
4. - Pedicels 10 to 40 mm long. Tepals often widely overlapped with the neighbors. Corona usually with three more or less deep scales, rarely entire and subtriangular or more rarely circular in section - ***N. deficiens*** Herb . (*N. miniatus* Donn . - Morg ., Koop. & Zonn .)
Sensu grupo "Narcissus" group (*N. obsoletus* sensu 'Flora Iberica')

- Pedicels 25 to 65 mm long. Tepals, in general, more or less narrow, not overlapping with the neighbors. Corona (sub)entire or irregularly crenate and circular in section - 5
5. - Plant more or less robust. Tepals lanceolate, with the maximum width from the middle part towards its distal end. Entire corona, with thick and contracted margin at its end - ***N. obsoletus*** Steud . sensu grupo "Narcissus" (*N. elegans* sensu 'Flora Iberica')

- Graceful plant in all its parts. Sublinear tepals, with the maximum width closer to the base. Corona subentire or irregularly crenate, with fine margin and not contracted at its end. - ***N. elegans*** Spach sensu grupo "Narcissus"
