| Distinctive Features | Violet flowers with large creamy white throat |
| Closest Relatives | <u>Crocus kotschyanus</u> ; <u>Crocus vallicola</u> |
| Cultivation Requirements | Moisture retentive, free draining soil. Do not allow to dry out completely in summer |
| Availability | Very rare in cultivation |
