

Crocus cancellatus pamphylicus

Flowering Time	Autumn
Distribution	S Turkey
Native Climate	Mediterranean, relatively high rainfall
Wild Habitat	Rocky places in scrub
Distinctive Features	Pale flowers, white anthers, netted corm tunic
Closest Relatives	<u>Crocus cancellatus mazziaricus;</u> <u>Crocus cancellatus damascenus;</u> <u>Crocus cancellatus cancellatus;</u> <u>Crocus cancellatus lycius</u>
Cultivation Requirements	Winter protection away from native regions, dryish summer rest
Availability	Rarely offered

Distinct from the other subspecies by its' white anthers, subspecies pamphylicus has a relatively restricted distribution in the Western Taurus mountains.
