Fibrous corm tunic, netted <u>Crocus kosaninii; Crocus vernus vernus</u> Can tolerate moist conditions throughout the year. (Grown outside in UK gardens) Horticultural clone 'Zwanenberg' is widely available from bulb suppliers.
