

# Crocus fleischeri

Flowering Time	Early Spring
Distribution	S and W Turkey; Eastern Greek islands
Native Climate	Mediterranean
Wild Habitat	Rocky slopes and thin woodlands, grows in heavy alkaline soils
Distinctive Features	Starry white flowers, bright orange red style. Corm tunic fine interwoven fibres
Closest Relatives	A distinct species
Cultivation Requirements	Alkaline soil, warm dry summer rest
Availability	Specialist bulb suppliers

A very distinctive species with small but striking flowers and a very distinctive corm tunic. No other species has fibres interwoven in this way.
