tunic thin fibres, finely netted

Closest Relatives Crocus hadriaticus

Crocus pallasii

Cultivation Requirements Winter protection advised away from native climate.

Warm dry summer rest

Availability Specialist bulb suppliers

Distinct from Crocus pallasii through its yellow throat and from Crocus hadriaticus by its stronger lilac colouration and some leaf characteristics.
